

CIT TRAINING IN TRUMBULL COUNTY



Trumbull County's first CIT training was held in February 2006 and was attended by eight officers from three jurisdictions (Howland, Liberty, and Warren City). Our sixteenth training session was held in October 2018 and was attended by 20 officers from eleven jurisdictions. This brought the total number of officers trained to 241 and jurisdictions represented to 31.

Departments with the largest number of trained officers are Warren City, Trumbull County Sheriff's Office, Howland Township, Hubbard Township, Liberty Township, Niles City, and Hubbard City. Click [HERE](#) for a complete listing.
