Position Title: Director of Clinical Services

Reports To: Associate Director

Primary Responsibilities

- 1. Monitors the mental health programs and services delivered by provider agencies within the Trumbull County Mental Health and Recovery Board network for content and appropriateness.
- 2. Serves as the liaison between TCMHRB, community providers and the state psychiatric hospital system.
- 3. Facilitates the continuous quality improvement committee meetings.
- 4. Oversees legal and probate functions of TCMHRB.
- 5. Develops and negotiates contracts with hospitals to provide inpatient psychiatric care to indigent Trumbull County consumers.
- 6. Monitors/oversees local and regional private hospital psychiatric unit utilization with contracted provider agency.
- 7. Develops and implements Purchase of Services contracts and Memorandum of Understanding agreements.
- 8. Supervises the Director of Planning and Evaluation and provides oversight to Independent Contractors including the Clinical Compliance Auditor, Chief Clinical Officer and Board Attorney.
- 9. Responsible for Culture of Quality updates and implementation.
- 10. Co-facilitates the Trumbull County Suicide Prevention Coalition.
- 11. Responsible for updating and/or creating policies related to mental health and crisis services.
- 12. Develops or participates in the development of community activities that enhance the community's awareness of TCMHRB and/or the supports/services needed in the community.

- 13. Assists in the production of annual and long-range service delivery plans and identifies service gaps via this process.
- 14. Assists with development of the annual TCMHRB budget and the annual report.
- 15. Attends various community and state meetings as appropriate.
- 16. Develop and assist in development of various reports and plans as required by OhioMHAS.
- 17. Other Tasks as assigned.

Essential Functions of the Position

Reading, with/without magnification, both printed documents and information as it appears on computer screens.

Sitting for moderate time lengths while attending various meetings; working at desk, etc.

Driving while traveling to various meetings and/or functions properly assigned to this position.

Manual dexterity as it relates to writing, operation of computer keyboard and various items of office equipment, such as printers/copiers.

The ability to communicate verbally and in written form in a professional and understandable fashion.

Primary Requirements

Master's degree or above in the field of mental health, drug/alcohol abuse treatment, psychology, social services, or social work.

Licensed Independent Social Worker or Professional Clinical Counselor required.

Knowledge of the field of services/supports appropriate for individuals eligible for Board services.

Ability to analyze data and make/recommend appropriate course of action as required to the Executive Director.
