Mental Health Services (MH)

A mental illness may affect a person’s thinking, feeling, behavior or mood. These conditions may impact daily living and affect the ability to relate to others. If you or someone you know has a mental illness, you are not alone. For help contact one of the agencies with MH by its name.

Substance Use Disorder Services (SUD)

Substance use disorder and addiction inhibit a person’s ability to control the urge to use substances like drugs and alcohol despite negative consequences. Recovery is possible with the appropriate support, tools, and services. For help contact one of the agencies with SUD by its name.
