

Don't keep unused or unwanted Medications in your house!

Proper disposal of unneeded or old medication can prevent prescription drug abuse.

Do not flush unwanted medications, as they may get into our water supply.

The best way to dispose of meds is to take them to a drop box at the following locations:

If you can't get to drop off location....



Take unneeded medication out of the original container and mix it with coffee grounds, cat litter or sawdust.



Place mixture in a disposable container, such as a sealable plastic bag.



Place sealed container in the trash.



Remove all personal information from empty medicine bottle and recycle it.
